The Ethical Society Nursery School continues our esteemed early childhood education program through our 2022 Summer Camp. Join us for any or all weeks during our June and July offerings below and experience the joys and benefits of play-based learning at our exciting half day camps. Have fun as we collaborate, investigate and play. Engage in storytelling, music, nature walks, water play and so much more.

A Day at Camp: 8:45am- 11:45am

With a healthy, safe experience as our top goal, we are excited to provide in-person learning with a mask wearing policy for children and staff. This summer, we are committed to as much outdoor play as possible, on the playground, porch and with nature walks in the Ethical Woods. Children sing and dance in music class. We also learn from Becky and Nature on the Move. Classroom time includes projects, activities, science experiments and crafts built around the weekly theme. Experienced teachers support cognitive development while building social/emotional skills. Join us as we learn through play.

June 6-10: Colors and Shapes

Dive into a week of learning about colors and shapes. What colors and shapes can we find on a nature walk? Is neon a color? Explore different art mediums. Build and sort with large and small shapes. Do yoga in the "rainbow room." Colors and shapes are incorporated into our crafts, books and music.

June 13-17: Solar System

It's out of this world! Fly to the moon with ESNS as we learn about our solar system. Which is the biggest planet? Why is Mars the red planet? What is a star? How does the moon change shape? Learn about the moon, earth and galaxy and how humans explore them.
